Guidelines for **KHSI SCHOLARSHIP**

1. Eligible applicants must be U.S. college students or high school seniors who are (or will be) attending a college, university , or technical/trade school of their choice.
2. Applicant must be either a current youth member of KHSI (membership is free) or their immediate family must be members of KHSI.
3. Applicant must be under 26 as of January 1, 2026 if applying for support for graduate or undergraduate school, and must have been involved with the Katahdin sheep industry for at least one year.
4. KHSI will award at least five (5) \$1000 scholarships in 2026. This number may vary depending on eligibility of funds
5. Applicants may only receive the KHSI Scholarship one time.
6. Applicants who are not awarded a scholarship are encouraged to reapply.
7. Undergraduate and graduate level students are eligible to apply.
8. The KHSI Scholarship Committee will judge the applications. Scholarship recipients will receive an official letter and their award by mail. Scholarship recipients will be announced to the KHSI Membership at the 2026 KHSI Expo in Cookeville, TN on Friday, July 31, 2026.
9. Complete applications must be postmarked by the deadline or they will not be reviewed.
